Patient Information

Your patch test result indicates that you have a contact allergy to paracetamol. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching and fluid-filled blisters.

Where is paracetamol found?

Paracetamol is commonly found in medications for the relief of fever, headaches, and other minor aches.

How can you avoid contact with paracetamol?
