Where is this allergen found?

p-tert-butylphenol is a formaldehyde resin found in adhesives. Products such as shoes, handbags, belts, watchstraps, glues, varnishes, lacquer resins, motor oil additives, rubber antioxidants, printing inks, masonry sealant, insecticides, deodorants, and commercial disinfectants could contain this substance.

How can you avoid contact with this allergen?
