Where is this allergen found?

Caine mix [A] contains three anaesthetics for topical use: benzocaine, dibucaine hydrochloride, and tetracaine hydrochloride. It is found in products that reduce pain, itching, and stinging. The mix is also found in haemorrhoidal preparations and cough syrups.

How can you avoid contact with this allergen?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:

- benzocaine
- dibucaine hydrochloride
- tetracaine hydrochloride
- tetracaine-HCL
- cinchocaine-HCL

What are some products that may contain this allergen?

Medications

- Analgesics
- Antiseptics
- Hemorrhoid treatments
- Lozenges for coughs and sore throat
- Over-the-counter first aid treatments for pain and itching of injured skin
- Prescription therapies for ear and eye inflammation
- · Sprays for coughs and sore throat
