Where is this allergen found?

Erythromycin is an antibiotic prescribed mainly for people who are allergic to penicillin. It is often used for respiratory tract infections and in the treatment of STDs, syphilis, acne, and other bacterial infections.

How can you avoid contact with this allergen?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:
