Where is this allergen found?

Oxyquinoline mix contains the antibacterial and antifungal actives clioquinol (CAS #130-26-7) and chlorquinaldol (CAS #72-80-0).

How can you avoid contact with this allergen?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:
