Patient Information

Your patch test result indicates that you have a contact allergy to phenylbutazone. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching, and fluid-filled blisters.

Where is phenylbutazone found?

Phenylbutazone is found in equine medications for the treatment of analgesia (pain relief from infections, sprains, arthritis) and antipyresis (reduction of fevers).

How can you avoid contact with phenylbutazone?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:
