### **Patient Information**

Your patch test results indicate that you have a contact allergy to urethane-dimethacrylate. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching and fluid-filled blisters.

### **Where is urethane-dimethacrylate found?**

Urethane-dimethacrylate is a cross linker for anaerobic adhesives and dental compounds.

### **How can you avoid contact with urethane-dimethacrylate?**

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:

- 2-hydroxyethyl methacrylate
- 2,4,4-trimethyl-1,6-diisocyanatohexane
