Patient Information

Your patch test result indicates that you have a contact allergy to indomethacin. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching, and fluid-filled blisters.

Where is indomethacin found?

Indomethacin is an anti-inflammatory found in drugs used to reduce fever, pain, stiffness, and swelling.

How can you avoid contact with indomethacin?
